Freedom Transit's Blue Line to Extend to New Human Services Building

Gettysburg, PA – rabbittransit will extend its Gettysburg fixed route service, Freedom Transit, to connect with the new Adams County Human Services building at 525 Boyds School Road. Beginning Tuesday, March 21, 2017, the Blue Line will make three additional trips to this location including 7:45AM, 10:45AM and 2:15PM. Other drop-off locations are available en route including Misty Ridge.

“We continuously seek ways to partner with Adams County and this was a chance to provide access for residents to reach important community resources,” comments rabbittransit Executive Director, Richard Farr.

Freedom Transit is comprised of three main lines including the Blue Line, Gray Line and Lincoln (Red) Line that connect at the Gettysburg Transit Center at 103 Carlisle Street. Riders may transfer to other lines at this location including the 15N rabbitEXPRESS commuter service that travels between Gettysburg and Harrisburg.
