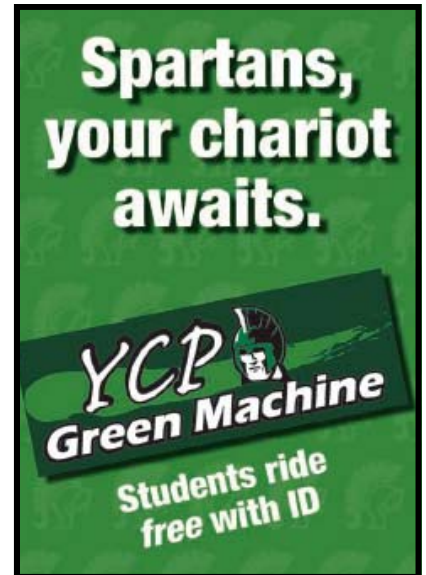
Green Machine Gets Ready

rabbittransit will be joining several other downtown organizations in the area by hosting a table at the NE Neighborhood Block Party.

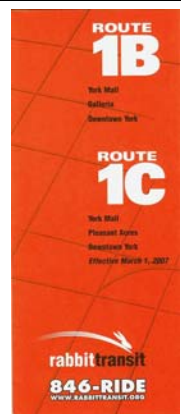

A New Face for Route 1

Increased congestion and traffic have led to on-time performance issues for one of rabbittransit's most popular routes — Route 1.

In an effort to revitalize the route, rabbittransit employees have reviewed different scenarios that might serve as solutions. Several possible alternatives include adjusting the headways or frequency and changing the routing.

The revamping of route 1 is the first step in implementing part of the Transit Development Plan (TDP) which was created this past year. The TDP is a study conducted every 5 years to ensure the maximum efficiency of resources.



Fair Frenzy

We will again be providing service to the York Fair, which runs from September 7 to 16.

In York: Just hop on any stop on Routes 1 through 6. The cost to ride is only 50¢ after 5 pm.

In Hanover: Hop on Route 16. The cost to ride is only 50¢ after 2:15pm.
