The first production in the Children's Series line up includes "A Winnie-The-Pooh Christmas Tail" which opens December 7 and plays for two consecutive weekend performances.

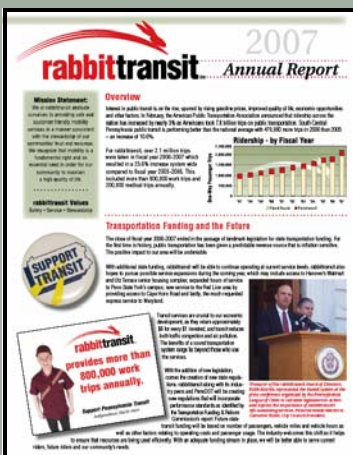

## Calling Commuters: New Survey

On Friday, December 14, rabbittransit will launch a new survey targeted to commuters traveling to the York City Area from Southern York County. The survey outlines topics ranging from vanpooling to express service.

A similar survey was offered for Maryland commuters last fall, but service was delayed from launching as federal capital funding for buses was not allocated. However, rabbittransit is still hopeful of the possibility to head south and in the meantime, is focusing on inter-county commuting which could utilize existing vehicles.

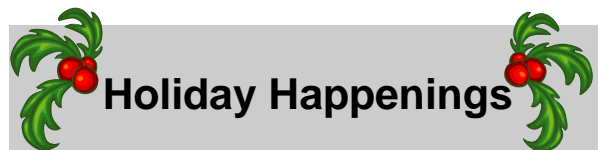
