Vanpools Reduce Commuters' Carbon Footprints

rabbittransit and Commuter Services of South Central Pennsylvania announced they have formed two new vanpools. Each vanpool helps its riders reduce their carbon footprints by half and also reduces traffic congestion in York County.



Rep. Eugene DePasquale (95th District) was on hand to lend support for this initiative reducing both greenhouse gases and traffic.

Two new 14-passenger vanpools will depart from Shrewsbury to travel to Fort Meade, Maryland, on a daily, weekday commute. The first vanpool coordinated by rabbittransit and Commuter Services started Friday, February 1.

To further champion the use of vanpools, rabbittransit is providing a \$200 per month subsidy per 14-passenger vanpool.
