**Transit Celebrates New Funding!  
Service Cuts Averted**

The Pennsylvania General Assembly and Governor Edward Rendell adopted a plan to resolve the severe revenue shortfall facing transit services across the state, which will provide a program to allow those systems to move forward into the future. This funding compromise will allow rabbittransit to avoid major service cuts. rabbittransit is slated to receive over \$900,000 in new transportation funding.

Highlights of the new legislation include the creation of a new Public Transportation Trust Fund in the State Treasury, a complete restructuring of mass transit funding and the first single dedicated fund for transit. The legislation also establishes mandatory performance standards for transit agencies to ensure efficient use and equitable distribution of funds. Had this legislation not been enacted, more than 100 million of the 400 million public transportation rides provided each year could no longer have been taken by passengers across the state.

Mass transit is growing faster than ever. Unfortunately, adequate funding to maintain the infrastructure and redevelop our transit systems has not met demand. In addition, federal funding continues to decrease, leaving Pennsylvania's transportation system in dire need of help.

That is why I fought to make sure rabbittransit would be included in the state's transportation bill. Because of our efforts, rabbittransit is expected receive an increase around \$900,000 -- an annual increase of almost 50 percent -- a greater percentage increase than Philadelphia or Pittsburgh.
