Dump the Pump: Fuel Your Wallet

Thursday, June 19, marks "Dump the Pump Day," an annual event which encourages people to: "Save your money. Save the planet." Transit use in the United States saves an estimated 1.4 billion gallons of gasoline a year or 4 million gallons a day helping to reduce a non-renewable resource.

In honor of this gas-saving effort, rabbittransit will offer free rides on the fixed route buses for June 19 to encourage the use of public transportation for one day – and hopefully throughout the month. Dump the Pump Day is sponsored by the American Public Transportation Association (APTA) and will be celebrated nationwide.
