



## Specialty Transportation Programs

### Free Transit Cards

#### **Who is eligible?**

Senior Citizens who are:

1. 65 or older
2. Pennsylvania Residents

#### **Program Description:**

This card allows seniors to ride rabbittransit's fixed route bus for free anytime of the day or night during regular hours of operation. Seniors can catch the bus at any rabbittransit bus stop. The card also allows seniors to ride most public bus systems in Pennsylvania for free during non-peak hours (check local bus system schedules for more details).

#### **Cost:**

Free. With the Free Transit Card you can ride anywhere on rabbittransit's fixed route bus system absolutely free.

3. Proof of age is required to apply. The Acceptable Proofs of Age are as follows: Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate, Driver's License, PACE Card, State ID, Armed Forces Discharge Papers, Passport or Naturalization Papers, Veteran's Universal Access ID Card, Statement of Age from the Social Security Administration.

## **Senior Shared Ride**

### **Who is Eligible?**

Senior Citizens who are:

1. 65 or older
2. PA and York County Residents

### **Program Description:**

If you live anywhere in York County, rabbittransit will pick you up at your home (or another location of your choice) and take you to your destination, then pick up at a scheduled time and return you to your home. Most Senior Shared Ride destinations are within York County; however, rabbittransit also provides regular trips to Harrisburg, Hershey, Adams County and Lancaster based on demand. Check with rabbittransit for more details. You can use rabbittransit Senior Shared Ride service for any kind of trip; medical appointments, shopping, recreation, senior centers and more.

Shared Ride trips are scheduled based on demand. If there is not enough demand in a particular area at a particular time and rabbittransit's resources are needed elsewhere, rabbittransit reserves the right to change the requested time or to turn down the trip. rabbittransit makes every effort possible to meet the requests of customers based on the resources available.

### **Cost:**

There is a small co-pay each time you board the vehicle. The cost would range from \$1.00-\$2.75 depending on the purpose and destination of the trip.

3. Proof of age is required to apply. The Acceptable Proofs of Age are as follows: Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate, Driver's License, PACE Card, State ID, Armed Forces Discharge Papers, Passport or Naturalization Papers, Veteran's Universal Access ID Card, Statement of Age from the Social Security Administration.
4. A letter of confirmation and an ID number will be mailed to you.

## **Medical Assistance Transportation Program**

### **Who is eligible?**

Individuals who:

1. Are York County residents, including temporary residents.
2. Have Medical Assistance (hold an Access Card) and meet specific requirements.

### **Program Description:**

The Medical Assistance Transportation Program provides free transportation to medical appointments and to the pharmacy. Various transportation options are available based on accessibility including: fixed route transportation, curb-to-curb service, and mileage reimbursement. Call the office for more specific information on eligibility requirements and on the variety of non-emergency medical trips that are available at no cost to you.

### **Cost:**

Free. Transportation for medical appointments and visits to the pharmacy are absolutely free.

## **ADA Complimentary Paratransit**

### **Who is Eligible?**

Individuals, who because of their disability, cannot use fixed route service.

### **Program Description:**

ADA Complimentary Paratransit works for any trip that originates and ends within  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile (7 city blocks) of a fixed route bus. This service operates during the same days and hours as fixed route service. This type of transportation can be used for any kind of trip; medical appointments, shopping, recreation, senior centers and more.

### **Cost:**

One-way paratransit fares for ADA Complimentary Paratransit are \$2.50 for zone 1 or \$3.50 for zone 2 as of October 10, 2005.

## **Rural Transportation for Persons with Disabilities**

### **Who is Eligible?**

Individuals with a disability who need transportation in areas that are not serviced by the fixed route, that are not eligible for any other funding services and are between the ages of 18-65.

### **Program Description:**

This program works like the Senior Shared Ride Program, but for persons with disabilities. If you live anywhere in York County, rabbittransit will pick you up at your home (or another location of your choice) and take you to your destination, then pick you up at a scheduled time and return you to your home. Most destinations are within York County; however, rabbittransit also provides regular trips to Harrisburg, Hershey, Adams County and Lancaster based on demand. Check with rabbittransit for more details.

Shared-ride trips are scheduled based on demand. If there is not enough demand in a particular area at a particular time and rabbittransit's resources are needed elsewhere, rabbittransit reserves the right to change the requested time or to turn down the trip. rabbittransit makes every effort possible to meet the requests of customers based on the resources available.

### **Cost:**

One way Rural Transportation fares are between \$2.50 and \$3.50 depending upon the distance traveled.

## **MH/MR Transportation**

### **Who is Eligible?**

Clients of the York-Adams MH/MR Program.

### **Program Description:**

This program provides rides for eligible clients of the York-Adams MH/MR Program that are traveling to and from workshops such as at Shadowfax or the HART Center.

### **Cost:**

One way rides to these sites cost \$3.00.

## **Human Service Development Fund**

### **Who is Eligible?**

Income based and possible age restrictions.

### **Program Description:**

The Human Service Development Fund provides free transportation to medical appointments, the pharmacy, WIC, County Assistance and Social Security. Various transportation options are available based on accessibility including: fixed route transportation, curb-to-curb service, and mileage reimbursement. Funding for this program is limited. Call the office for more specific information on eligibility requirements and on the variety of non-emergency medical trips that are available at no cost to you.

### **Cost:**

Free.
