Hanover Junction Train Station and Museum

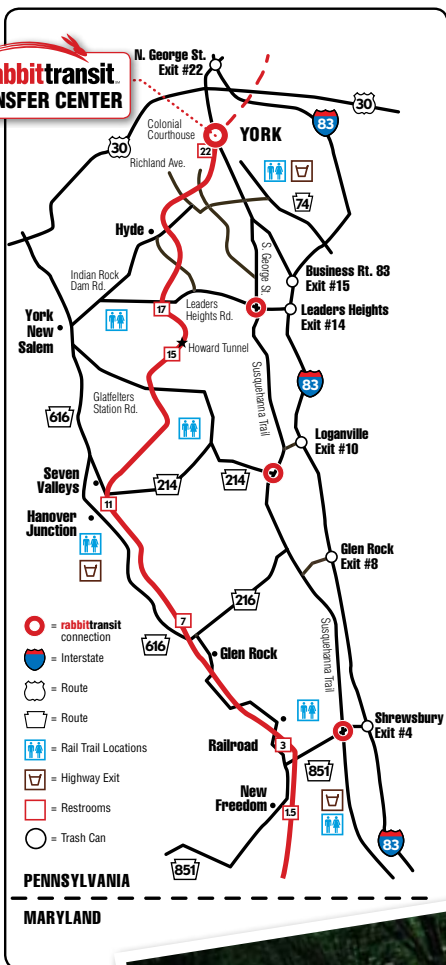
Quick Fact: Used by President Lincoln during the Civil War as he traveled to and from Gettysburg. Raided by Confederate Troops.
