

Senior Shared Ride Program Adams County

Seniors 65 Years of Age or Older

If you are traveling to a Senior Center, an Adult Day Care Facility, a Medically Related Appointment (including pharmacies), the Grocery Store or the Bank, the following copay will apply:

All Zones: \$0.00

For all other trip purposes, including group trips, the copay will be as follows:

Zone 1: \$1.20 (one-way)

Zone 2: \$1.75 (one-way)

Zone 3: \$2.35 (one-way)

Zone 4: \$3.85 (one-way)

Zone 5: \$5.35 (one-way)

Remember, the Fixed Route is **FREE** to registered seniors over the age of 65.

Seniors Between the Ages of 60-64

If you are traveling to a Senior Center, an Adult Day Care Facility, a Medically Related Appointment (including pharmacies), the Grocery Store or the Bank, the following copay will apply:

All Zones: \$0.00

For all other trip purposes, the following fares apply:

Zone 1: \$8.00 (one-way)

Zone 2: \$11.50 (one-way)

Zone 3: \$15.50 (one-way)

Zone 4: \$25.50 (one-way)

Zone 5: \$35.50 (one-way)
