


Overview

rabbittransit, a regional public transportation provider, offers a variety of transportation services to the residents of York, Adams and Northumberland Counties. Nearly 7,000 people depend on rabbittransit each day to get to work, medical facilities, school and other life-sustaining activities. rabbittransit is dedicated to helping all residents in the region get to where they want to go.

Facts

- rabbittransit provides 1.7 million trips per year.
- rabbittransit operates 12 routes serving York and its surrounding suburbs and three routes serving Hanover.
- Commuter bus service via rabbitEXPRESS provides access to Harrisburg, Hunt Valley, Timonium, and Towson.
- There are four (4) Park and Ride lots available to riders in York and three (3) in Adams County.
- rabbittransit connects to Lancaster via the Route 12 to Columbia.
- . A division of rabbittransit, Freedom Transit, provides public transportation on three fixed routes which serve the Gettysburg area including: the Blue line, Gray line and Lincoln line.

An 11 Ride Hop-n-Go Pass is ideal for riders who require flexibility. The 11 Ride Pass is good for 11 one-way trips.

These passes never expire and the trips do not need to be taker consecutively.

A 31 Day Hop-n-Go Pass is ideal for frequent riders. These passes offer unlimited rides in a 31-day period.

The pass does not need to be purchased on the 1st of the month, but rather the time period begins on the first date that the pass becomes activated in the fare box.



Commuter Services

rabbittransit's partner, Commuter Services of PA, helps employers identify mobility solutions. They can even help set up tax savings plans as part of their FREE services. Commuter Services also offers support through a variety of avenues including conducting transportation fairs; matching employees to carpools, vanpools, and emergency ride home programs; assisting with information about teleworking, flex time, staggered shifts and compressed work weeks; and other promotional and educational activities to make transportation alternatives a reality. Fixed Routes:

Employers who accommodate transit find they can expand their labor pool to better recruit workers. Fixed Route transportation provides an affordable, and for many, necessary alternative to driving. We offer 15 routes which serve York County daily.

rabbit EXPRESS:

Commuter bus service is a great way for employees to save money and forget the stress of traffic, gas prices and wear and tear on their cars! Weekday service is available via rabbitEXPRESS from York to Maryland (Hunt Valley, Timonium and Towson), York to Harrisburg and Gettysburg to Harrisburg.

An Emergency Ride Home (ERH) reimbursement program is available through our partner, Commuter Services of PA, to rabbit EXPRESS riders who commute at least twice per week.

Vanpools:

Vanpools are ideal for long-distance commutes. Free services are available to help commuters form a vanpool by locating and bringing together a group of seven to 15 people to share the ride and commuting costs to and from work. This is a turn-key program including insurance and maintenance. Subsidy assistance available for most groups.

We Offer a Variety of Alternative Transportation Solutions

Sudsidized Shuttles and Specialized Routes and Park and Ride:

Need transportation for your employees?
Perhaps we can collaborate on a new bus stop or deviate a route near your location.
Subsidized shuttles are becoming increasingly popular to get your workforce to where you need them.

Park and Ride:

Lots are available for connecting to alternative transportation solutions. Have a group of employees meet to carpool or vanpool from a designated Park and Ride location.

Employees can also use designated Park and Ride locations to connect to rabbittransit's fixed-route service via rabbit*EXPRESS*.



Travel Training

We'll Ride With You

Do you have employees who are interested in riding the bus, but they just aren't sure about it? We'll ride with them! We offer FREE travel training. which is designed to teach people how to better understand and navigate the fixed route bus system.

We offer hands-on training on how to:

- Plan your trip
- · Read and understand route maps and schedules
- · Get to and from your bus stop
- Pay fares and purchase tickets and passes
- · Get on and off the bus safely
- Use the lift and/or kneeler to board vehicles with a mobility device
- · Locate and transfer to other buses at the Transfer Center



Borrow-a-Bike **Program**

Bikes offer an opportunity to travel greater distances when connecting to transit. Riders can connect to bus stops that may have previously been out of reach because of long distances. Bike racks are available on every vehicle.
