CONNECTING SERVICE TO DOWNTOWN HARRISBURG

rabbittransit buses traveling to Downtown Harrisburg and the Amtrak Harrisburg Station depart from the Shippensburg Walmart at 5:40AM, 6:25AM and 5:25PM each weekday (except major holidays) and from the campus (Luhrs Center) at 6:15AM, 5:15PM and 5:40PM. Travel time to Harrisburg via I-81 is 60 minutes.



PA SENIOR CITIZEN FREE RIDE PROGRAM

Passengers 65 years of age and older ride free with a Commonwealth of PA Senior Citizen ID card.



HALF FARE PROGRAM

Passengers with a disability may be eligible for a special Reduced Transit Fare card which entitles the passenger to ride the fixed-route buses at half the regular fare. Persons with a Medicare Card qualify for this program. Senior Citizens may ride for half fare using a Medicare Card but are encouraged to apply for the Commonwealth of PA Senior Citizen ID card above.



ROUTE DEVIATION INSTRUCTIONS

Any person with a disability traveling within ¾ of a mile of the scheduled route may request the vehicle to deviate from its regular route (regardless of trip purpose) by calling 1-800-632-9063 between 7:00AM and 4:00PM the day before your trip, and we will deviate the bus to pick you up or drop you off.



FINDING THE RIGHT BUS

Raider Transit regularly operates two routes—the Red Line and the Blue Line. Each bus is marked with an overhead sign which indicates what line the bus is operating. To find the closest bus stop on your selected route, look for a bus stop sign. Stand beside the sign and the bus will arrive to pick you up.
