CCB quarterly update - Vernea Patterson Shaw 4th quarter, April, May, June 2025:

- 268 bus passes were issued = 2,070 trips.
- 401 new applications for MATP
- 22,172 trips booked.
- Mileage reimbursement was provided to 103 consumers totaling 2,589 trips.
- Out of county/premium trips, Philadelphia, Lancaster, Uber: 1,683 total.
- 16,702 incoming and outgoing calls.

SRTA August 2025 performance metrics distributed via e-mail prior to this meeting. Fixed route ridership Capital Region:

• 102,609 total. 4,616 less riders than in 8/2024.

50% on time, 28% late, 21% early.

Fixed route ridership York/Adams:

- 107,717 total. 19,142 less riders than in 8/2024.
 - 74% on time, 13% late, 12% early.

SRTA Paratransit ridership: 60,143 total trips booked amongst all the counties serviced by SRTA. 4,279 less than in 8/2024.

- No shows. 4,107 total = 56,036 trips completed.
 - 87% on time, 13% late.

SRTA Call Center: 31,572 total calls. 9,134 dropped. 71% answer rate.

Capital Region complaints: 79 in total, 19 were MATP.
