   The Rabbittransit fixed route crisis comes next year. So, they are not in position to ask for an emergency use of operating for capital until that time.

- The orange boxes seen on fixed route buses are the new bus pass validators.
- The design of the regular passes and the design of the reduced fare passes will be different.

**September 2025 performance metrics** distributed via e-mail prior to this meeting. Fixed route ridership Capital Region:

- 110,176 total. 3,099 more riders than in 9/2024.
  - 51% on time, 30% late, 19% early.

Fixed route ridership York/Adams:

- 107,378 total. 8,543 less riders than in 9/2024.
  - 75% on time, 13% late, 13% early.

SRTA Paratransit ridership: 59,986 total trips booked amongst all the counties serviced by SRTA. 4,279 less than in 9/2024.

- No shows. 4,176 total = 55,811 trips completed.
  - 84% on time, 16% late.

SRTA Call Center: 31,728 total calls. 10,292 dropped. 67.6% answer rate.

Capital Region complaints: 102 in total, 33 were MATP.

• Late trip, driver issue, accounting issue.

SRTA complaints minus Capital Region: 174

• Late trip, driver issue, accounting issue.
